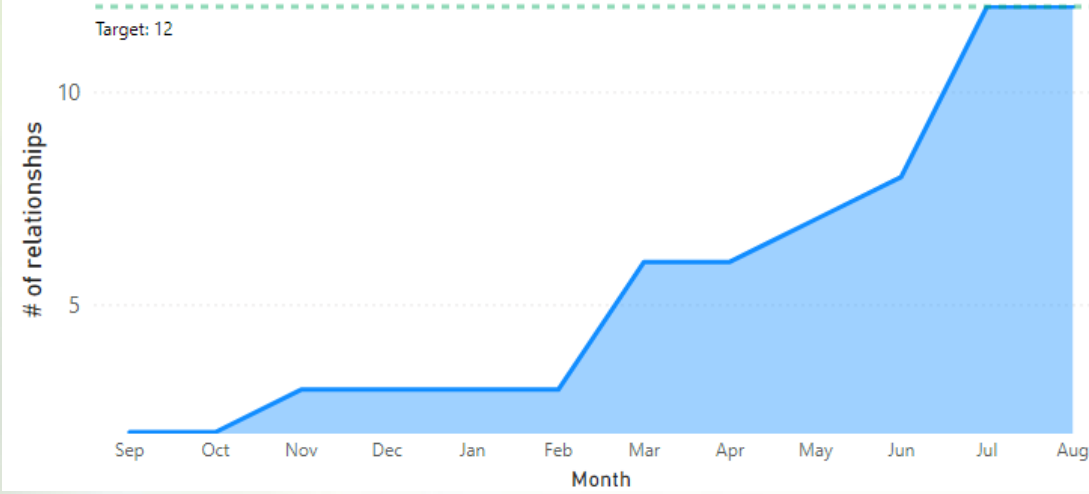

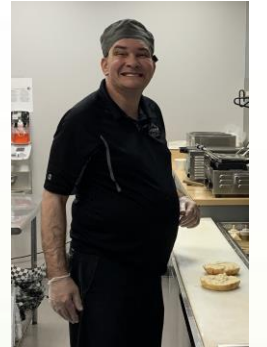
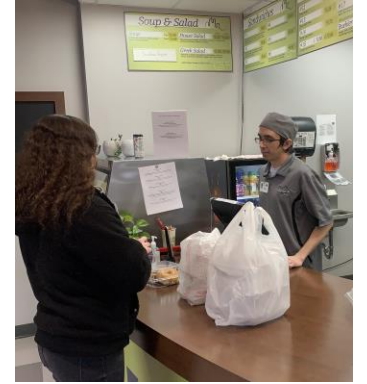
# BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

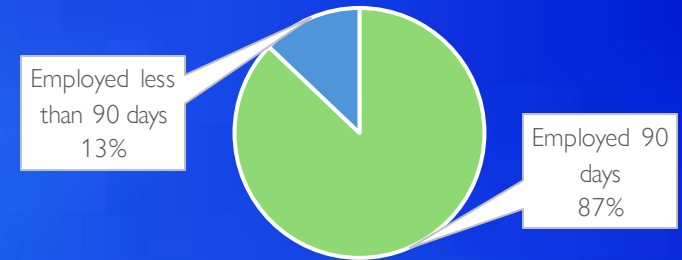

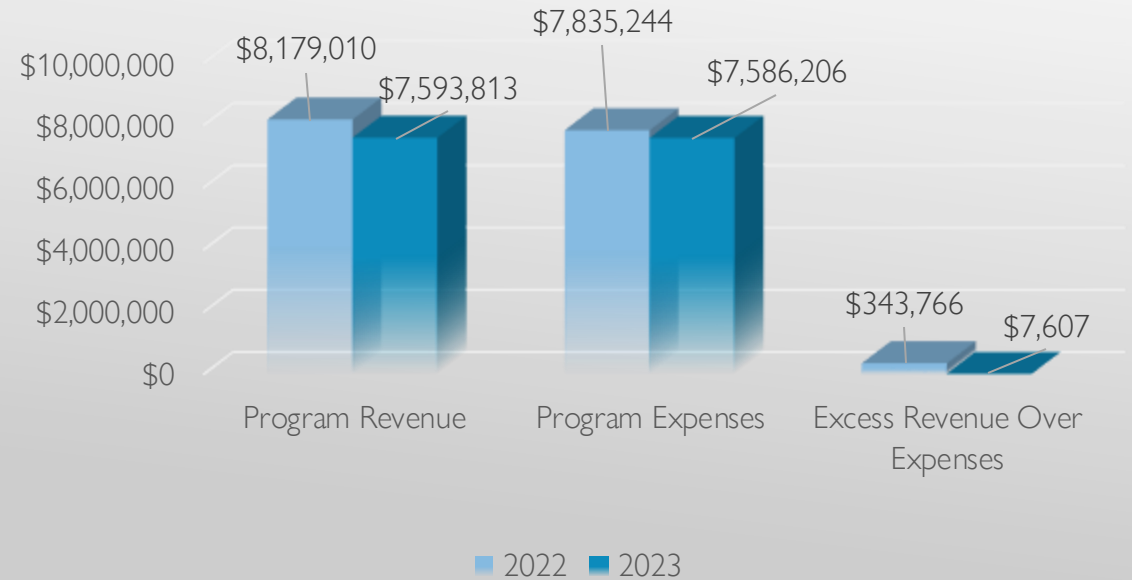
