





WARNING SIGNS FOR

HEART ATTACKS



CALL 911

immediately if

For men or women, most heart attacks start slowly with chest pain or discomfort. Women are more likely to also experience **shortness of breath**, **nausea/vomiting**, and **back** or **jaw pain**.

Warning Signs Include:

- Chest discomfort. Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.
- Discomfort in other areas of the upper body.
 Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.
- · Shortness of breath with or without chest discomfort.
- Other signs may include breaking out in a cold sweat, unusual fatigue, nausea and/or lightheadedness.

WARNING SIGNS FOR

STROKES



SUDDEN numbness or weakness of face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body



SUDDEN confusion, trouble speaking or understanding



SUDDEN trouble seeing in one eye or both eyes



SUDDEN trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination



SUDDEN severe headache with no known cause

ACT *F.A.S.T.*Call 911- IMMEDIATELY

Remember stroke warning signs with F.A.S.T.

FACE
Ask the person
to smile. Does
one side of the
face droop?

ARMS
Ask the person
to raise both
arms. Does one
arm drift
downward?

SPEECH
Ask the person
to repeat a simple
phrase. Is their
speech slurred
or strange?

TIME
If you observe
any of these
signs, call 911
immediately.
